- With more foot and bike traffic in the mornings and afternoons, please be extra cautious, adhering to the posted speed limit when driving through the community in the mornings and afternoons.
- Stay alert and never pass a bus when its lights are flashing and the stop sign arm is extended. They will be loading or unloading children who may need to cross in front of the bus.
- Be sure to slow down at crosswalks and watch for children who may dart into the roadways unexpectedly.
- For the safety of all, please arrive at the bus stop at least 5 minutes early. While waiting for the bus, do not stand in the street or too close to the curb, and wait until the bus comes to a full stop before approaching it.



Please note: If a duplicate work order is placed, and the first one has not been completed, the new request will be cancelled and will merge with the original request.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

Grilling Safety Tips for Summer Barbecues: Keep your cookouts safe and have fun with these quick tips.

- Always grill outdoors, away from buildings, balconies, and trees. Set your grill on a flat surface and use a grill
 mat to prevent tipping.
- Clean and remove any charcoal and grease buildup, disposing of it in a metal container. If the flame goes out on a gas grill, turn off the gas and wait a few minutes before re-lighting.
- If you are grilling, never walk away, leaving your grill unattended. Always keep children and pets at a safe distance. Use starter fluid only on unlit charcoal and never add it to a live flame.
- For safety purposes, be sure to wear close-fitting clothing and shoes when grilling.
- Lastly, remember never to use water on a grease fire. Keep baking soda and a fire extinguisher nearby to extinguish any fire.
