COMMUNITY TRASH SCHEDULE

Refuse bins may be placed at the curbside after 6:00 PM the evening before your scheduled collection day, but please ensure your bins are at the curb by 7:00 AM on collection day, unless your Community Team states otherwise. As a reminder, receptacles must be returned to their proper storage location by 8:00 PM on the day of collection.

The trash company will not pick up bulk items or items that do not fit within the trash containers, even if they are placed curbside. These items must be disposed of separately. For a list of local transfer stations and pricing, please contact the community office.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

With temperatures dropping, it is almost time to turn the heat on. When doing so, please remember to keep the fan option in the "Auto" position when you switch from AC to Heat.

The "ON" setting runs your HVAC fan continuously, increasing energy costs and potentially causing discomfort from the wind chill effect, especially in winter. The "AUTO" setting only runs the fan when the heating or cooling system is active, saving energy and reducing wear on the fan motor and HVAC system.

*Please remember that when you switch to heat, you will need to call in a work order to have your HVAC filter changed and your dampers adjusted so that your heating is the same upstairs and downstairs. Dial (845) 716-7511 and press 1 to place a work order.
