Christmas and New Year's Day Office Closures

As a reminder, the Community Offices will be closed on Thursday, December 25th, in observance of the Christmas holiday and will reopen at 8:00 AM, Friday, December 26th.

The Community Offices will be closed on Thursday, January 1st, in observance of the New Year's holiday and will reopen at 8:00 AM, Friday, January 2nd. If you have an urgent or emergency maintenance-related issue, please call (845) 716-7511 and press 1.

When leaving the premises for an extended period during the winter months, do not turn off the heat completely. Instead, lower the thermostat to a safe setting of approximately 50°F to 55°F. Maintaining this temperature helps prevent frozen pipes and reduces the risk of water damage.

Holiday Decoration and Lighting Guidelines

To maintain the safety of our community, residents are asked to observe the following standards regarding holiday decorations and exterior lighting.

- **Placement of Decorations** Holiday decorations and exterior lighting are permitted only when positioned below the edge of the roof gutter. To ensure safety, decorations are not permitted in the second-story areas of the home.
- Attachment Methods The use of staples, nails, screws, or other mechanical
 fasteners to secure decorations or lighting to homes or associated structures
 is strictly prohibited. Commercially available plastic clip-on hooks may be
 used for attaching decorative lighting, garlands, and similar items. Nothing
 may be affixed to vinyl siding.
- **Decoration Standards** All holiday decorations must be in good taste and consistent with the traditions and standards of the holiday being observed. Decorations must be removed within one week following the holiday.
- **Electrical Safety** All electrical decorations must be unplugged whenever the Tenant is away from the Premises.

What to do with extra holiday trash – Bulk item collection is not available at our site. All items must fit within the designated trash containers in order to be collected. Please break down cardboard boxes and place them inside the bin so that the lid can close securely. How to dispose of their live tree after the holiday? – You can dispose of your Christmas tree for FREE at Newburgh and New Hampton Orange County Transfer Stations until January 31st. The trees must be natural, with all ornaments, lights, and decor completely removed.

- Transfer Station #2: located at 21 Training Center Lane, New Hampton, NY 10958

Winter Weather Safety & Snow Removal Guidelines

As winter weather arrives, we ask all residents to observe the following guidelines to ensure community safety and efficient snow removal operations.

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping our community safe and ensuring that snow removal operations can be completed efficiently.

- Avoid Playing on Roadways While the hill leading up Barrett Drive may appear inviting during snowfall, for
 the safety of residents and our snowplowing staff, please do not slide down, play in, or make tunnels in the
 snow along the roadways.
- **No Roadway Parking During Snowfall** Parking is strictly prohibited on all roadways during impending or active snowfall. Please monitor weather forecasts closely. Vehicles must be removed prior to a storm so that road surfaces can be pre-treated and cleared effectively. Any vehicle left on the roadway during snow removal or treatment will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.
- Snow Removal from Driveways and Sidewalks When clearing your driveway and sidewalk, do not shovel or blow snow into the main roadway. This creates hazardous conditions, narrows the road, reduces visibility, and increases the risk of accidents. Please place snow onto the lawn area adjacent to your driveway.

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping our community safe and ensuring that snow removal operations can be completed efficiently.

COMMUNITY TRASH SCHEDULE

Please ensure refuse bins are at the curb by 7:00 AM on collection day, unless your Community Team states otherwise. Refuse bins may be placed at the curbside after 6:00 PM the evening before your scheduled collection day. To help keep our community tidy and limit the ability for trash to blow around and/or be accessed by animals, please do not place bins prior to 6:00 PM.

As a reminder, bins must be returned to their proper storage location by 8:00 PM on the day of collection.

TRASH & RECYCLING
Pickup Every Friday

The trash company will not pick up bulk items or items that do not fit within the trash containers, even if they are placed curbside. These items must be disposed of separately. For a list of local transfer stations and pricing, please contact the community office.

To help keep our community tidy, please do not place bins curbside before 6:00 PM.
