February is typically the coldest month of the year, and we want to help everyone stay safe, warm, and prepared as temperatures drop.

Here are a few tips and reminders during freezing conditions:

- Protect your pipes by letting faucets drip slightly, opening cabinet doors to allow warm air to circulate, and insulating any exposed plumbing.
- Set your thermostat no lower than 60 degrees and never turn your heat off, even if you are planning on being away.
- Make sure your heat registers or baseboard heaters are not obstructed.
- Prepare for icy conditions by keeping salt or ice melt on hand for walkways and steps, and use caution when walking or driving.
- Bring pets indoors and limit their time outside during extreme cold to keep them safe.
- Keep your garage door closed.



#### Winter Weather Parking Reminder:

Parking on the roadways during active or impending snowfall is prohibited. Any vehicles parked on the roadway will be subject to towing at the owner's expense so that we may properly remove snow from the roadways. Residents may utilize the community center parking lot if needed. We kindly request that vehicles be removed from the parking lot in a timely manner, allowing for snow removal to occur in the lot as well.

## COMMUNITY TRASH SCHEDULE

Please ensure refuse bins are at the curb by 7:00 AM on collection day, unless your Community Team states otherwise. Refuse bins may be placed at the curbside after 6:00 PM the evening before your scheduled collection day. To help keep our community tidy and limit the ability for trash to blow around and/or be accessed by animals, please do not place bins prior to 6:00 PM. As a reminder, bins must be returned to their proper storage location by 8:00 PM on the day of collection.

The trash company will not pick up bulk items or items that do not fit within the trash containers, even if they are placed curbside. These items must be disposed of separately. For a list of local transfer stations and pricing, please contact the community office. To help keep our community tidy, please do not place bins curbside before 6:00 PM.
